Above is a five year tracking grid displaying the ITBS scores. This table is a summary of the results of the Iowa Test of Basic Skills administered to students in grades three, five, and seven. If you have younger children and are not familiar with the standardized tests administered at St. Monica, this test is mandated by the Milwaukee Archdiocese. Comparisons are provided by grade level for a five year period. Please keep in mind that composition of classes varies from year to year so some variance in achievement should be expected. The table provides the percentile rank of students at St. Monica compared to national school norms.
