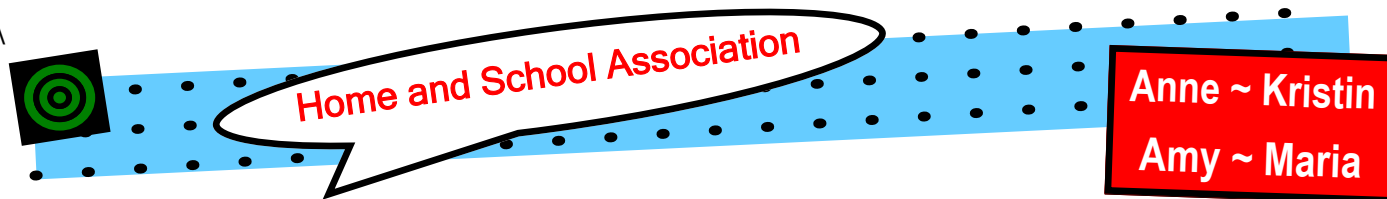
A Proper School Uniform Means:

What if St. Monica School earned a penny every time you searched the Internet or shopped online? Well, now we can!

[GoodSearch.com](http://www.goodsearch.com) is a new search engine that donates half its revenue, about a penny per search, to the charities its users designate.
