The Pepsi Refresh Project has accepted the Sojourner Family Peace Center's proposal in a national contest, with the winner of \$250,000 chosen by nationwide popular vote. Voting can be done DAILY through January.

Safe Exchange & Supervised Visitation Project (SESVP) is intended to be a one-stop center for families in the greater Milwaukee area to exchange children peacefully and to receive essential services, including parenting and anger management classes, and timely referrals of parents and children to other services. The center would be available to families of all income levels, and **there is currently no place in Milwaukee County of its kind, leaving a huge gap.**

The Project is intended to provide the following:

- ✓ a place where parents involved in domestic violence safely exchange their kids
- ✓ a place where children can go to visit with a parent they haven't seen in a long time (for a number of reasons), and have that visit supervised by professionals to ensure the safety (physical and mental) of the child
- ✓ a place where professional resources are assembled to provide parents and children with real-time assistance

Here's how to vote:

HOW TO VOTE the first time:

1. Go to: <http://www.refresheverything.com/safeexchange>
2. On the bottom of the webpage click, "Sign In."
3. There are two ways to sign in:
 - a. If you are already signed on to Facebook, click, "Login with Facebook" and you will automatically be logged on to the Pepsi Refresh website.
 - b. Otherwise, type in your email address and click, "No, I'm new here!"
 - c. You will then be taken to a webpage where you will fill out your name, email address, and a password for logging onto the Pepsi Refresh site.
 - d. Type in your birthday and fill out the security check.
 - e. Click, "Done," and you will then be logged on and ready to vote.

VOTING each time thereafter is a quick login and vote. **NO SPAM WILL RESULT FROM VOTING!**
