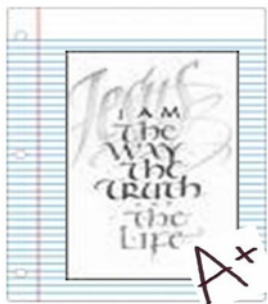

IMPORTANT HEALTH NOTICE FOR SIXTH GRADE PARENTS:

According to the recently revised State of Wisconsin Law, two immunization booster shots are required for all children entering 6th grade this year.

They are the Dtap and Varicella adolescent booster shots.

Without proper documentation, students who do not show proof of these immunizations may be prohibited from attending school this fall.

Please send proof (complete dates) of these two immunizations to the school's clinic, Attn: Mrs. Feuerstein, by September 18, 2009.

If you have recently scheduled an immunization appointment, let us know the date of the appointment, as well as providing the actual date of immunization once the immunizations have been received.
