

STUDENTS WITH EXCEPTIONAL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS
(School Board Policy, established May, 1995)

The principal will monitor the progress of children who have been identified as having “Exceptional Educational Needs”, including periodic conferences with St. Monica School teachers, and attendance at such children’s Multidisciplinary Team meetings and Individual Educational Plan (IEP) meetings.

Parents of children with exceptional educational needs will be given a copy of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee policy #5111.2 within a week of their child’s IEP meeting. The principal will secure from one or both parents a signed statement, “I have read the above”, with respect to policy #5111.2.

If the principal, in consultation with teachers at St. Monica School determines (1) that our school cannot provide a program that can meet the special needs of an Exceptional Educational Need Child, based on the recommendations of public school educational specialists at an IEP meeting, or if (2) a student’s presence here is detracting from the instruction provided for other children, or if (3) a student’s presence here is a safety hazard for him/herself or other children, then the EEN child’s enrollment at St. Monica School will be terminated.
